- 1. How many individual breakers are available in buildings #1 & #2, and what amperage each? Who is responsible for screenings transportation and disposal? Page 3 Services provided by Contractor item 3 reads “Provide trucks to haul grit, rags and other materials that cannot be land applied to State of California licensed landfill site.” Page 3 Services Provided by City at no Cost to Contractor item 1 reads “Trash bins and disposal of screenings.”**
City will provide bins, hauling, and disposal if accepted by Turlock Scavenger.
- 2. If trash bins are provided for screenings will they be moved/replaced as needed so the cleaning contractor is not waiting?**
City can coordinate bin change out with Turlock Scavenger. Historically, we have not needed to change out bins mid cleaning.
- 3. Will the City provide drawings of the digesters?**
